
- 1,050 telephone interviews with California voters likely to participate in the November 2020 election
- Conducted March 30-April 9, 2017
- 56% of interviews conducted via landline and 44% on cell phones
- Margin of sampling error ±3.0% at the 95% confidence interval
- Due to rounding, some percentages do not add up to 100
