2016 Criteria

- Understand and be an articulate advocate of CSBA's role, vision, mission, and governance structure.

2016 Criteria (cont'd)

- Have the experience, knowledge and conviction to lead CSBA and represent the Association with integrity.
- Demonstrate knowledge of education finance, budget and accountability issues on a statewide basis.
- Must be sensitive to and understand the impact that the legislature has on public education.
- Ability to enhance the power and influence of local school and county board members.

Timeline

- May 25 (Wed) – Deadline for three officer nomination forms to be received by CSBA
- June 30 (Thurs) – Deadline for declaration of candidacy packets to be received by CSBA
- July 23 (Sat) – Paper screening and selection of candidates to be interviewed
- August 6 (Sat) – Interview selected candidates
- October 17 (Mon) – Deadline to “make public” the nominations for Vice President and President-elect (Requires notification at least 45 days prior to election)
