4	Amends 101012	<p>Changes amounts of bond proceeds and requires them to be available for new construction and modernization as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Construction: Reduces amounts for new construction to \$1.8 billion (from \$1.9 billion). Requires on or after July 1, 2014, 50% of unencumbered balance previously available for seismic repair, reconstruction or replacement pursuant to 17075.10, shall be available for new construction and 50% for modernization. • Modernization: Increases amount of modernization funds to \$3.4 billion (from \$3.3 billion). • CTE Facilities: Reduces amount for CTE facilities to \$497 million (from \$500 million) and as of June 30, 2014, of the amount not yet approved by SAB, 50% shall be available for new construction and 50% for modernization. • Severely overcrowded schools: Reduces amount for new construction for severely overcrowded school sites to \$990 million (from \$1 billion). Of the amount not approved by SAB by June 30, 2014, 50% to be available for new construction program and 50% shall be available for modernization. • High performance schools: Reduces amount for high performance schools to \$65 million (from \$100 million). Of the amount not approved by SAB by June 30, 2014, 50% shall be available for new construction and 50% available for modernization. 	2
