

# Is Your School ALL IN for Health?

**ALL YEAR 2014-2015** *Healthy students make good learners.*



**YOUR SCHOOL** can help students, parents, and employees get and keep affordable health coverage. Let families know about these important dates.

- ▶ **Enroll in Medi-Cal anytime** if you are eligible.
- ▶ **Lost your health coverage?** Find out if you qualify to enroll during Covered California's Special Enrollment Period.
- ▶ **Renew your Medi-Cal coverage every year.** Look for a letter from your local county social service department requesting information. Complete and return.
- ▶ **Renew or change your Covered California health coverage** between October 1 and December 15, 2014. Covered California will contact you to make sure you keep coverage.
- ▶ **If you don't have health coverage and don't qualify for Medi-Cal, open enrollment** starts November 15, 2014 and runs through February 15, 2015.
