Babies and young children grow, learn, and develop best when they receive quality health care. Early learning and child care providers and directors can play a vital role in connecting children, families, and staff to health coverage.

- ▶ Provide materials tailored to the early learning and care community on health coverage programs through Covered California and Medi-Cal;

- ▶ Provide technical assistance to early learning and care providers.

### What you need to know

- ▶ Open enrollment into affordable coverage through Covered California is November 15, 2014 – February 15, 2015.
- ▶ Eligible children, families, and individuals can enroll in no- or low-cost Medi-Cal year round.
- ▶ Medi-Cal and Covered California coverage needs to be renewed every year. Enrollment counselors can help.
- ▶ Special enrollment through Covered California may be available anytime for those who have lost their health coverage outside of the open enrollment period.
