

The Challenge

- Recruiting and retaining staff remains a top challenge
- Housing costs are pushing LEA staff out of the communities they serve
- California LEA staff need more affordable housing
- LEAs are looking for a sustainable, long-term staffing solution

The Opportunity

- LEAs have a lot of underutilized land in desirable locations
- Legislation makes it easier for LEAs to build housing on their property
- Completed developments show improved retention, waitlists

A New Professional Development Opportunity

- CSBA developed the Education
 Workforce Housing Bootcamp to support individuals and teams in the early stages of exploration
- One-day, in-person training designed to move individuals and teams from interest to action


