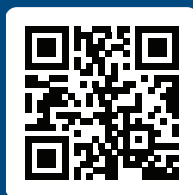

Facilitators will offer best practices that can be immediately developed and implemented at the school level while engaging all stakeholders and encouraging student voice as a valued and necessary contributor to positive change toward equity.

- » Understand a system's approach to interpreting patterns of inequities within the district through development of an equity statement, policy and action plan
